This NGO currently has **2,300 volunteers** distributed in **45 different locations** in Argentina.

We are constantly working on training new teams of volunteers to develop more projects.







The objective is to **accompany people who live in the streets** on a social re-insertion process through different areas

Every night different groups of volunteers visit homeless people to generate a bond of trust and work together in their reintegration through different areas of work, such as:

- Addictions
- Labor inclusion
- School inclusion
- Animals
- Health

It's a project destined to work on the **emotional development of children and teenagers** of needed communities through games, art workshops and sports.

Every weekend a group of volunteers shares different activities with children to work on the **development of their self-esteem** and their abilities.







We promote the **increase of opportunities** for the access of young people from **rural areas** to universities, to articulate them with the needs and demands of the region where they come from.

We opened:

- 2 houses in Santiago del Estero
- 1 house in La Rioja
- 1 house in Córdoba
- 1 house in Catamarca
- 1 house in Salta
- 1 house in Rosario
- 1 house in Neuquén



In 2019 we will open 2 more houses in Corrientes and Tucumán



Bank of musical instruments

The program seeks to **strengthen levels of education**, encourage selfesteem, and develop values of discipline and responsibility.

We collect musical instruments and provide them for free to Argentinian lowincome children and adolescents.







We provide immediate and long term assistance on natural catastrophes all across the country.

We work in three fases:

1. We focus on the **emergency**, so we send what is necessary to cover the basic needs: food, water, diapers, clothes and medicines.

2. We made a **deep survey**, door to door, family by family, to gather information about the losses of each of them.

3. We focus on the **re-equipment** of work tools.





Productive Entrepreneurship

We promote the **work culture** and **generate incomes** to families that assist to comunitary centres where we work at.

We work to **empower single mothers** in their possibilities and potential opportunities.







All these projects is carried out through private donations, both from the community and from companies that collaborate with the organization.
